- The Library reserves the right to refuse any exhibits, including but not limited to those that primarily promote commercial interests, as determined by the Library.
- The Library reserves the right to refuse, discontinue, and/or remove the exhibit or any individual pieces of the exhibit at any time without notice.
- Customers may protest the presence of any work of art or exhibit within the Library's buildings or grounds. Protests will be reviewed by a committee of librarians. The committee will make a recommendation to the Library Director. The customer may appeal the Director's decision to the Library Board, which will make the final decision.
